- ⇒ ...that each church can send two (2) voting delegates to our district convention the weekend of Friday April 30th and Saturday May 1st in beautiful Plymouth, Mass.
- ⇒ ...that the keynote speaker for the LWML-NED Convention on Friday evening, Heidi Floyd, will also be the Humorous Interrupter at the 2011 LWML Convention in Peoria, Ill. What does that say about her if they are having her back again? So come and be inspired as Heidi shares how God lifted her up and comforted her in the midst of storms in her life.

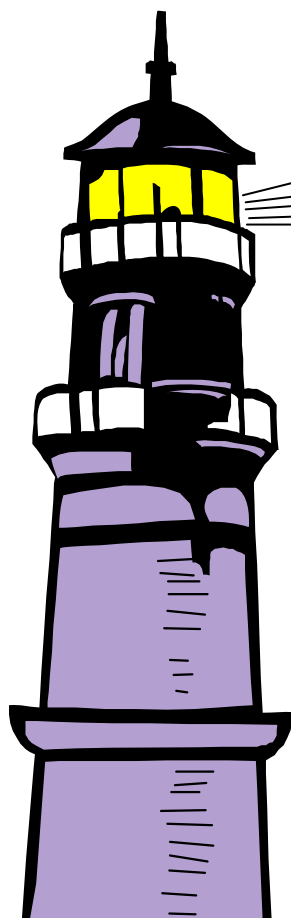

**To meet our mission goal for 2008-2010 of \$53,075.00, we need to collect \$2,211.46 each month.
 As of February 15, 2010, we fell short of our twenty-one month goal by \$4,811.07.**

65% of all mites collected go to LWML-NED mission grants (\$34,498.75)

25% of all mites go to LWML mission grants (\$13,268.75)

10% of all mites go to LWML-NED administration costs (\$5,307.50)

To meet our mission goal for 2008-2010 we need to collect another \$6,873.78 in mites by March 30!
